Ian Sykes is best known for pioneering the development of the Nevis Range ski area on Aonach Mòr, and for founding the Nevisport chain of outdoor shops. He has been a long standing member of the Lochaber Mountain Rescue Team and was awarded an MBE in 1990 for his significant contributions to sport and mountain rescue.
